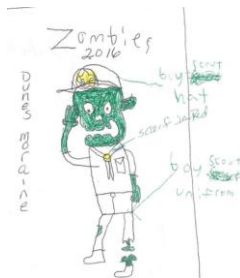

#### Events

- Z-bie Challenges Test your Scouting skills in this land overrun by Z-bies
- Ghoulish Dish Create your most Z-bie like dish for judging and sharing
- Z-bie Snow Scout Build your most Z-bie like snowscout
- Z-bie Sled Race Is your patrol faster than a Z-bie
- Sled Judging Sled should be made of bark covered wood or dimensional lumber, no metal fasteners or hardware, sled should be large enough to transport a 6 ft person laying down.

#### Z-bie Survival Challenges

- Deliver the Z-bie Vaccine to the Topenebee survivors of the Z-bie attack
- To deliver the Vaccine each patrol will need to complete 8 challenges.
- At each challenge the Scouts will
  - Demonstrate their ingenuity and Scouting skills
  - Determine the GPS coordinates (UTM) for each station (fire ring) so we know where the Z-bies have been. Turn in coordinates at Scouter's West after your last station.
  - Receive one of the ingredients to the Z-bie Vaccine to deliver to the survivors

<b>Start</b> 8:45	Training Center	Opening Ceremony and Start	Staff
<b>1</b> 9:00-9:25	Pines North	<b>Fire Sled</b> Build a fire then transport burning coal(s) on your sled through the Z-bies to get to the survivors so you can start a fire to warm them.	T 907
<b>2</b> 9:30-9:55	Shawnee	<b>Give Me A Sign</b> Erect a free standing flag pole at least 10 ft high with your patrol flag at the top to signal the rallying point for all survivors	T 995
<b>3</b> 10:00-10:25	Pines East	<b>Help!</b> Provide first aid for the survivors who have escaped the Z-bies.	T998
<b>4</b> 10:30-10:55	Parade Field	<b>Finders Keepers</b> Use compass skills to locate clues to solve the puzzle	T 926
<b>5</b> 11:00-11:25	Mohawk	<b>Flying Steel</b> ?	T 908
<b>6</b> 11:30-11:55	Pines South	<b>Up in the Air</b> Z-bie ice worms are coming. Lash a tripod and hoist your sled one foot off the ground then get your whole patrol on the stump.	T 963
<b>7</b> 12:00-12:25	South of Scouters E&W	<b>Give me Shelter</b> Protect survivors of the Z-bie attack by erecting an emergency shelter using your tarp(s)	T 904
<b>8</b> 12:30-12:55	Seneca	<b>Protective Shelter</b> Use available materials to construct a defence against Z-bie	T928
<b>Finish</b> 1:00	Scouters West	<b>Doctor, Doctor Give Me the Cure</b> 1. Turn in list of GPS coordinates of stations 1 – 8. 2. Receive Instructions on how to finish the vaccine. Patrols complete the vaccine at their campsites as part of lunch preparations.	Staff

**Patrol Equipment List for Z-bie Challenge:**

- Tarp(s) for emergency shelter
- Rope 6ft length for each patrol member (6 pieces of rope minimum)
- 100ft length of rope
- Fire Starters (matches, flint and steel, hot spark, etc.)
- Tinder/kindling
- Compass (at least two per patrol)
- 1st Aid Kit
- Three scout staves, each at least 6 ft long
- Tent pegs/stakes
- GPS Receiver/Cell Phone with GPS App
- Knife
- Hatchet with sheath, and/or hammer/mallet
- Clip board with paper 8 1/2 x 11 for mapping
- Pencil/pen
- Patrol Flag
- Blanket/Sleeping Bag
- Signal Mirror
- Flash light
- Hand saw
- Water, one bottle per Scout
- Metal can/bucket or other suitable container to transport burning coals
